Creation and mandate

Maasai Mara University was established under the Maasai Mara Charter 2013 with the mandate to teach, conduct research, innovate, provide consultancy and community services

Commitment

- Recruit and retain qualified staff and continually enhance their competence on emerging trends in relevant areas of specialization.

- g) Satisfy applicable customer, stakeholder, contractual and all legal and statutory requirements including laws, regulations, and contractual requirements related to information security, including data protection laws
- h) Take into account relevant educational, scientific and technical developments;

- k) Consider the needs and expectations of relevant interested parties.
- 1) Ensure sensitive information is protected from unauthorized access or disclosure.
- m) Safeguard the accuracy and completeness of information, preventing unauthorized modification or tampering.
- n) Ensure information and systems are accessible and usable when needed, maintaining operational continuity.
- Proactively identify, assess, and mitigate risks to the university's information and systems to ensure a secure environment.

The top management shall ensure that quality objectives, educational organization objectives and information security objectives are established in key functional areas, communicated and reviewed for continuing suitability and sustainability.

This policy and the integrated management system shall be reviewed at least once every 5 years and revised whenever necessary to keep it abreast with emerging issues within the University.

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
