Subject: Mandatory Course Registration and Examination Eligibility Requirements

The University Senate, in its meeting held on 13th January 2026, directed that all students under the New Funding Model (2023, 2024, and 2025 cohorts) must register for their courses on the ERP system with immediate effect in preparation for examinations commencing on 26th January 2026. Students in the 2022 cohort are likewise required to complete their course registration as usual.

To qualify for the forthcoming examinations, students in the 2022 cohort must ensure that **all fees are fully paid**, while students under the New Funding Model must have **cleared the Household Fee Component** in full. No student will be permitted to sit for examinations unless they meet these financial and registration requirements.

All course registration and fee-payment obligations for **every student** must be fully completed **by Friday, 16th January 2026, at exactly 12.00 p.m.** This deadline is final, and non-compliance will result in disqualification to sit for the examinations. **Further, no student will be allowed into examination rooms without University ID. Those yet to pick up their IDs should do so from the ICT department.**
