### **SUBJECT: ELIGIBILITY TO SIT FOR END OF SEMESTER II EXAMINATIONS**

Reference is made to several reminders on the above subject.

The End of Semester II examinations commenced today, **Wednesday April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, and will continue through **Wednesday April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. While the examinations have begun smoothly, it is imperative to address several significant concerns that have been observed:

1. A number of students have failed to register for their courses despite having fully paid their examination fees. Consequently, their names do not appear on the official examination attendance registers.
2. Numerous students continue to experience unresolved issues concerning funding, bursary allocations, and disbursements, even as the examinations are underway.

The Vice-Chancellor, acting on behalf of the University Senate, has authorized a limited window—**Wednesday April 15<sup>th</sup> to Friday April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026**—for students to resolve all outstanding matters related to eligibility to sit for examinations. During this period, you will be permitted to participate in the examinations as you present your specific cases to the Registrar, Academic Affairs, and the Student Finance Department for review. **Note that payment of Household fee component is MANDATORY.**

Let it be clearly understood that beyond this grace period, if your issues remain unresolved, you will not be permitted to continue sitting for the examinations. While the University is committed to supporting you through these challenges, it is essential that you take immediate action to ensure your compliance with all requirements.
