SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR GOVERNMENT FUNDING THROUGH THE HEF PORTAL

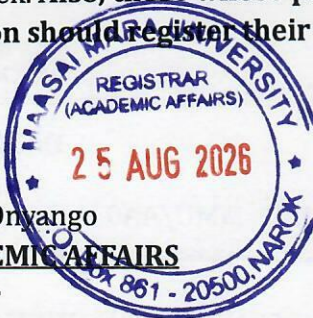
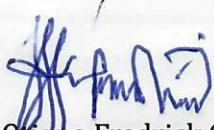
All first-year students in the 2026 cohort are reminded that the deadline for application for Government funding through the Higher Education Financing Portal is **31 August 2026**. Students who, for whatever reason, have not yet applied for loans and scholarships through the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) and the Universities Fund (UF) are advised to seek immediate assistance.

You are therefore requested to proceed to **LT015, Ole Karei Building**, where university officials will be available to assist you with the application process through the HEF portal at **www.hef.co.ke**.

Please ensure that you have the following information and documents with you:

1. Your valid email address, ensuring that you can log in to your email account.
2. Your telephone number.
3. Your KCPE index number and year of examination.
4. A copy of the sponsorship letter in PDF format, if you were sponsored in primary school.
5. Your KCSE index number and year of examination.
6. A copy of the sponsorship letter in PDF format, if you were sponsored in secondary school.
7. Your university/college admission number.
8. Your passport-size photo in JPEG, JPG or PNG format.
9. A copy of your National ID/Maisha Card, both sides, in PDF format.
10. Your birth certificate in PDF format, if you are under 18 years of age and do not have an ID.
11. Your valid bank account number or M-PESA number registered in your name.
12. Your parents' National ID numbers and registered telephone numbers.
13. A copy of your parent(s)' death certificate in PDF format, if deceased.
14. Two guarantors' ID numbers and registered telephone numbers.

Students are asked to act promptly to avoid missing the deadline. For further clarification, kindly visit LT015, Ole Karei Building, during working hours (between 8.00am to 5.00pm) the whole of this week. **Also, those whose parents intend to pay the full cost of their university education should register their details with the same office.**
